



2022 Stan Harter Memorial \$1,000 Scholarship

Stan Harter, January 12, 1943 - June 9, 2014

Stan Harter was a good friend of Del Nose, Coach for the Northwest College Rodeo Team, Powell, Wyoming, and Mary Fuller, 1968 NIRA Goat Tying Champion, Missouri. Del and Mary are donating in memory of Stan, the \$1,000 scholarship to be awarded at the June College National Finals Rodeo.

Harter competed for Arizona State University and was the 1966 NIRA Champion Calf Roper and Ribbon Roper. He was a steady winner in calf roping in the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association, qualifying for the National Finals Rodeo in Oklahoma City from 1970-73. In 1970 Stan finished fifth in the world after regular season wins in Houston, Texas and Oakdale, California; and was 19th in the all-around. He placed in five of 10 rounds in his first NFR to finish fifth in the tie-down roping average and was among the top five in the average standings in three of his four NFR appearances. Stan was president of the NIRAA and a long-time supporter of college rodeo.

The criteria for the scholarship are as follows:

- Must be a timed event cowboy or cowgirl,
- Must be a freshman, sophomore, or junior planning to receive a degree,
- Must be an NIRA member in good standing with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better,

The scholarship recipient will be selected by a committee appointed by the NIRAA, Inc. Board of Directors.
