QUALIFICATIONS

- * Must be an active, participating member in good standing of the NIRA and the individual's college or institution
- * Must be academically eligible and making satisfactory progress toward an educational goal
- * Demonstrate RAWHIDE principles with regard to positive choices, commitment to personal fitness, balance of rodeo and other responsibilities, and academic and career goals
- * Evidence of civic and/or community service
- * Evidence of peer leadership
- * Dedication to achieving personal best in rodeo event
