Through the generosity of the Bill Robinson – Walt Garrison Trust the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Foundation Board of Directors has elected to offer grants to National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association member schools in need, including brand new NIRA schools. Grants will be distributed in amounts ranging from \$250-\$2,000, to be determined by the foundation board of directors, annual disbursements not to exceed \$2,000. Some examples of need include: practice equipment, club facility utilities (electricity/water), membership fees, recent hardship expenses, newly establishing club expenses, etc. – but not limited to above). Special consideration will be given to new schools looking for financial assistance while establishing new rodeo programs. Annual disbursement for the grant program will be \$2,000; therefore, smaller requests will be given preference.

Please submit this application, a cover letter of request detailing specific item(s) to be funded, and any supporting materials to the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Foundation, 2033 Walla Walla Ave., Walla Walla, WA 99362. The foundation board meets twice a year, in December and June. Applications should be submitted no later than November 20th, and May 20th, of each year. Grant decisions will be made during these meetings, with disbursements made immediately following the meetings.

The foundation board reserves the right to investigate all requests for financial support.
